Thomastik-Infeld, string manufacturer based in Austria, was founded in 1919. Strings made from material other than temperamental gut revolutionized the string industry. The synthetic core DOMINANT strings became the reference standard strings. Currently Thomastik-Infeld produces more than 3,000 different strings each year - 80 percent of those for bowed instruments for sale in more than 100 countries.

The company's product range consists almost entirely of strings for all traditional bowed and plucked instruments (with the exception of the harp, the zither and the piano) used in classical, pop, jazz and folk music. The strings on offer aren't limited to just Western European instruments, there are strings available for the Turkish long-necked lute, the saz and the Arabian lute, the al-ūd. For numerous other instruments from Arabia, Africa or Asia, the company is capable of producing the right strings.

A small part of the business, inseparable from strings, is the sale of tailpieces for violins, violas, celli and double-basses, as well as several varieties of rosin.
